

5.1	Presentation to Board – English	English Curriculum Leader, Marcela Roberts, shared data on Year 3 achievement and progress and shared what changes and agreed practices have been implemented and introduced the Centre 4 Excellence professional development program that we're participating in, which incorporates very explicit teaching and learning in the classroom.
5.2	Presentation to Board – Maths	Maths Curriculum Leader, Andrea Harris, introduced Prime Mathematics and gave an overview of what the program looks like and how we deliver it in the classroom. Prime Maths is an explicit teaching model, all teachers are using it across the school. Maths should be taught for 6 hours/ week, 1.5 hours per day to get through the program.
