5.3	Reporting to Parent Sem 1 Parent Interview [uptake]	Parent feedback received by the school indicated the Individual Reports and Evidence of Learning folders sent home at the end of Semester One were outstanding and with feedback that the reports supported by the Evidence of Learning were the most informative they've ever received. The rating scale has changed this year, we no longer apply 10 bands of achievement, we now report with individual performance Exceeding, Achieving, Developing or Needs Support. Our preliminary data shows we need to maintain our focus on Spelling, Grammar & Numeracy.
